

Display your bling with this DIY jewelry tree!

Reminder

Make sure a grown-up helps you with this craft. Only a grown-up should use the acrylic or spray paint and the hot glue gun.

What You'll Need

- Dried tree branch with lots of limbs, washed and dried
- Optional: white acrylic or spray paint
- Nail polish in your favorite colors
- Plant pot - we suggest using one that's wide, sturdy, and heavy
- Optional: hot glue gun and hot glue sticks
- Something heavy to fill the pot with (to anchor your jewelry tree) -- for example, rocks, sea glass, sand, etc.



How To Make It

1. Select a dried tree branch that has lots of limbs, is not too heavy, and not too light either.
2. Wash it well and let dry for a day.
3. Optional: have a grown-up paint the tree white. Let dry.
4. Apply nail polish to the tips of the branches as you wish for a decorative touch. Let dry.
5. Place the tree branch in a plant pot. Optional: secure the tree branch to the bottom of the pot with hot glue and cover up with rocks, sea glass, or sand. If you choose not to use hot glue, simply fill the pot with rocks, sea glass, or sand until the branch is stable.
6. Hang jewelry on the branches.
