MATERIALS

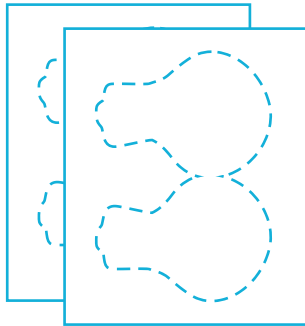
- Color printer

- Glue



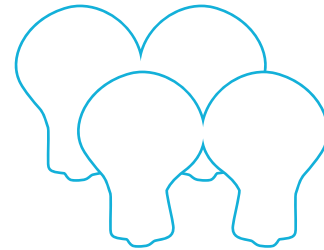
Note: Cutting intended for grown-ups only.

INSTRUCTIONS

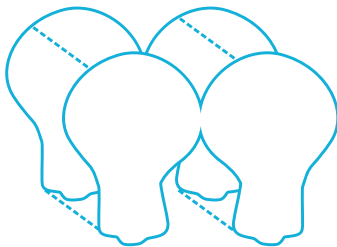
1 Customize the inside of the invitation by typing party information in the space provided. Then print all the pages of the invitation on heavyweight paper and set aside to dry.



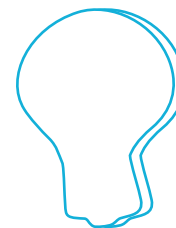
2 Cut out both sides of the invitation, cutting just inside the dotted lines.

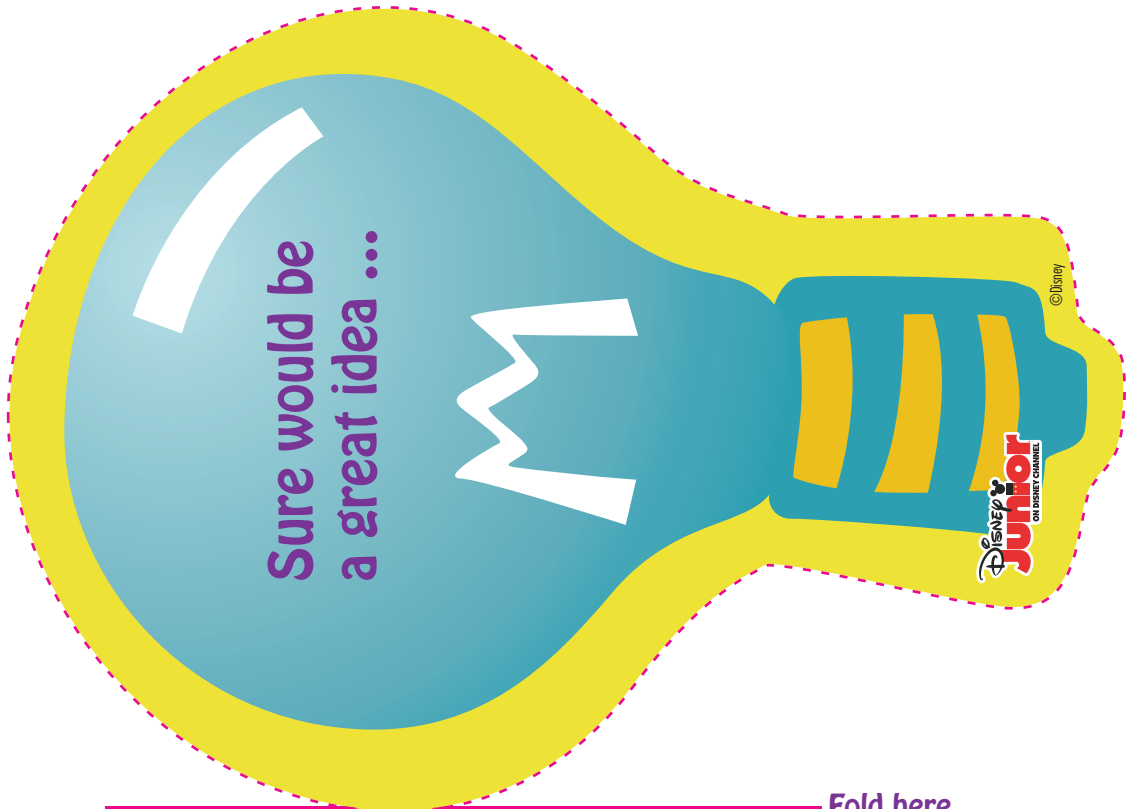


3 Paste the front and back of the invitation together using glue.

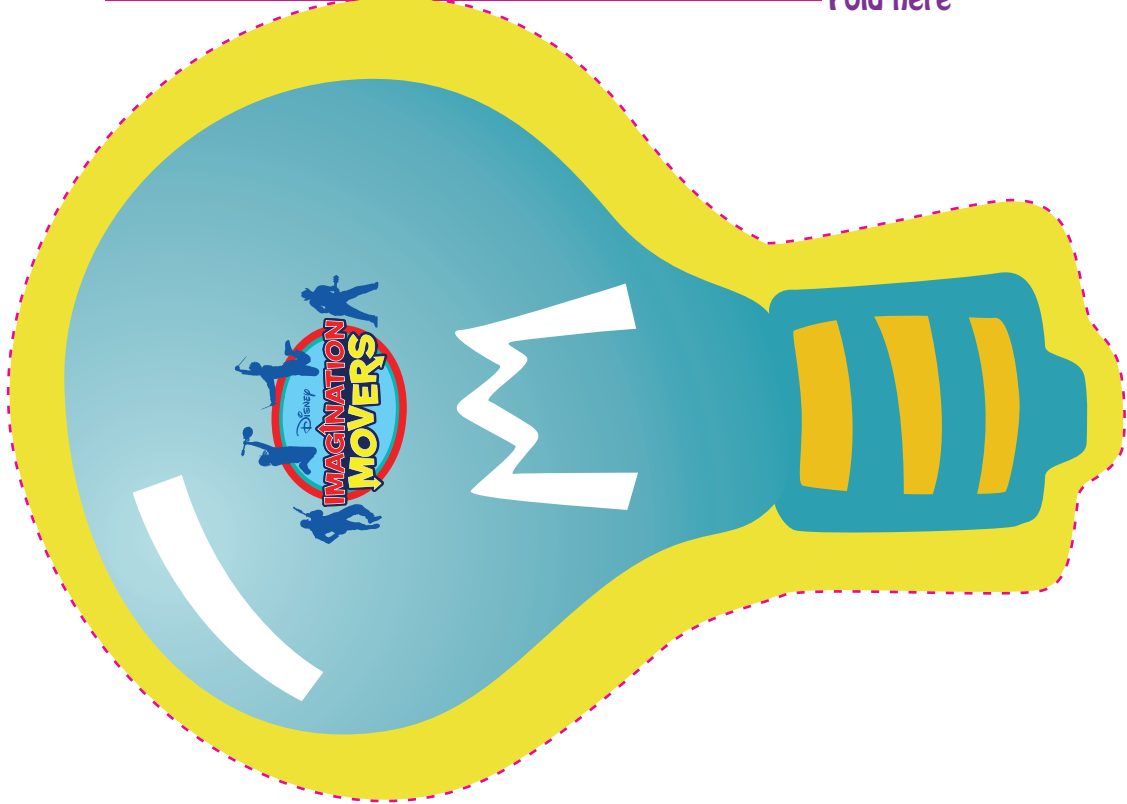


4 Carefully fold the invitation in half. You are ready to send your invites out to all your friends!
