



MATERIALS

- 1 or more sheets of 8.5" x 11" heavyweight paper
- Ribbon, yarn, string or tape
- Scissors or cutting tool

INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: Cutting intended for grown-ups only.




Decide what you want your banner to say and edit the text in the project artwork. Click on the existing letter, delete, and type in your own letter.





Print your banners and allow to dry completely.





Continue this process until you've printed all of the letters of your banner.






Using scissors or a cutting tool and cutting mat, trim away the white areas around the artwork.







Punch holes on the side of each letter and string together with ribbon or yarn.





You can display your banner in a variety of ways, such as hanging them on a line and using clothespins to suspend each letter, or attaching them to a wall or mantel with tape.
