Challenge yourself or a friend to remember where each card can find its match.



Materials: Card-Stock Paper Scissors Tape

Step 1: Print

Load card-stock paper following printer instructions. (Handle paper by the edges to avoid fingerprints.) Print **Memory Game Template** using your ink-jet printer. (For best results, load only one sheet at a time.)

Tips & Tricks:

To select the proper print settings in Adobe Acrobat, click Print; in the print dialogue box select properties; choose the appropriate paper type; and then select the highest print quality.
We recommend that you run a test print on regular paper to double-check the layout and design. (If problems occur, check your printer manual for additional printing instructions.)

Step 2: Dry Let paper dry several minutes before handling.

Step 3: Cut Using scissors, cut out all your cards along the dotted lines. Step 4: Play

Place all 16 pieces onto your playing surface (the white side should be facing up.) The object of the game is to find all the matching pairs of cards.

Option 1: Playing by Yourself

Select two cards and turn them over. If both cards are the same, remove them from the game and continue playing. If the cards don't match, turn them back over and try again. The game is over when you have matched all of the pairs and all the cards are gone.

Option 2: Multiplayer Instructions

The first player selects two cards and turns them over. If the cards match, they are removed from the board. Play continues until he or she turns over cards that don't match. Then player 2 begins his or her turn. The game is over when all of the cards are gone. The winner is the player who has matched the most cards.
