













Materials: Ribbon or string, glue, paper clips, scissors, and tape

1. Print out all the pages of the teacher banner, including the instructions. Depending on how long you'd like your banner to be, print out each page as many times as you like.
2. Fold each page along the dashed line, and then carefully cut out each banner element. Be sure to leave each item connected at the dashed line. For the picture frame on page six, paste a picture of your child or have your child write a special message to their teacher in the white space.
3. Glue the backs of each of the pieces together. Wait a few minutes for the pieces to dry. Using a hole-punch, punch out the indicated hole on the item.
4. Hang each piece on the end of a paper clip. Then, cut a ribbon or string as long as you would like your banner to be. Starting about a foot or two in from one end of the ribbon, tie the other end of the paper clip to the ribbon. Continue down the length of the ribbon, spacing out the pieces evenly and alternating between pieces until you fill the length of the ribbon. Be sure to leave a foot or two on the other end.
5. Your banner is complete! Tie or tape it up on a teacher's chalkboard, desk, or across the windows of the classroom.
