









1. Print out all six pages of the Father's Day Tool Box Gift Card Holder on regular paper or cardstock. As you go through these instructions, you may refer to the helpful diagrams on page six. Cut out the Top and Bottom of the tool box. Make sure you cut all the solid lines, including the small lines near each of the tabs on both pieces. There are four small lines to cut on the Top and four to cut on the Bottom.
2. Lay the Top piece face up over the Bottom piece of the tool box. The Bottom should be face down. Glue the Top and Bottom of the box together. Next, fold along all the dashed lines (including the tabs) toward the inside of the box. Tape or glue each of the four tabs to the inside of the tool box.
3. Cut out the handle of the tool box and fold it along the center dashed line, so that the wood grain appears on the outside. Fold the tabs at the end of the handle on the dashed line. Place the handle in the box and glue or tape the tabs on the two indicated areas -- a dark rectangle on each side of the inside of the box.
4. Cut out both tools, leaving them connected at the dashed line and fold each tool in half along that line. Glue the backsides of the hammer to each other, and then do the same for the screwdriver. You now have two tools to place in the box.
5. Cut out the gift card pouch. Make the indicated folds (along the dashed lines) towards the inside of the pouch. Put glue on the tabs and let the other half of the pouch fold on top of them, creating an envelope. Slide the gift card inside after the glue has dried. Place the gift card pouch into the box so that the text ("You're the best, Dad!") is facing out, and the pouch leans against the handle. Your Tool Box Gift Card Holder is now complete! Give it to your dad on Father's Day.
